

Kinson Photo Club Membership Rules 2019/20

- 1 Membership will be open to all members of the public who are interested in photography. The Committee reserves the right to cancel or refuse membership.
- 2 Subscription to the Photo Club will be agreed each year at the Annual General Meeting and shall be inclusive of Associate membership of Kinson Community Association.
- 3 The Committee shall consist of Chairperson, Vice Chairperson, Secretary, Competition Secretary, Treasurer, Programme Secretary, SAPA Representative, Immediate retiring Chairperson (if applicable) and two members, all to be elected at the Annual General Meeting.
At Committee meetings five shall form a Quorum.
- 4 All Offices and Committee Members are eligible for re-election each year except the Chairperson who shall not be eligible for that office in two consecutive years (unless no other nominations are accepted).
- 5 The Photo Club shall meet on Mondays at 19:30 hours or on other evenings as decided upon.
- 6 Special Meetings may be convened by requisition signed by at least 60% of Club Members stating the purpose of the Meeting, and submitted to the Secretary at least fourteen days before the proposed meeting date.
- 7 A member may be expelled for inappropriate conduct or by majority vote at a Special Meeting convened for that purpose.
- 8 All Members must complete and sign an application form and abide by the Club Rules stated therein.
- 9 No alteration of, or addition to the Club Rules shall be made, except at Committee Meetings with the consent of the Club Membership, at the Annual General Meeting, or at a Special Meeting convened for that purpose in accordance with Rule 6.
- 10 Competition Rules shall be the responsibility of the Committee, but no change in the Competition Rules will take place without members being informed on two consecutive meeting nights, in order that Rule 6 may be invoked if considered necessary, to ascertain the feeling of the Membership.
- 11 Any proposals for Annual General Meeting or Special Meetings must be given to the Secretary in writing two weeks prior to the meeting.
- 12 Images of models taken and organized by the Club (other than in Club competitions) may not be used or published in any form without the permission in writing of the Committee or the model.

Kinson Photo Club Competition Rules (Revised January 2020)

There will be six sections:-

(A) Advanced Monochrome League Prints

(B) Members Monochrome League Prints

(C) Advanced Colour League Prints

(D) Members Colour Prints

(E) Advanced Digital Projected Images

(F) Members Digital Projected Images

COMPETITION ENTRIES (Maximum per Member)

Print entries: 3 Colour Prints + 3 Monochrome Prints

DPI entries: 5 per Member

Entry fee: £0.50 per **Print** or **DPI** Entered for each Competition

PRESENTATION

Sections (A) (B) (C) and (D)

Minimum **10"x 8" (256mm x 205mm)** Maximum **19.69"x 15.74"** (500mm x 400mm)
incl. mount.

Registration for entries to be made no later than **two weeks** before the competition.

All prints must be **IDENTIFIED** with Members Name on the rear top left corner together with a **PRINT TITLE** written on the paid up Competition Entry Receipt.

The Committee reserves the right to mark, record on the back of any print and retain for **S A P A** battles, any entered in the competitions.

Section (E) & (F)

DPI's to be **submitted** on a memory stick or by e-mail to the Competition Secretary, **two weeks** prior to the competition date, size **1400 x 1050** pixels at 300 dpi resolution, in Jpeg and **sRGB** format for KPC Club Competitions.

DPI Images for SAPA Competitions

DPI Images selected for SAPA Competitions will require sizing to **1400 x 1050** pixels at 300 dpi in Jpeg and **sRGB** format.

The overall winner of each section will be awarded a Certificate.

New members of the Club may enter sections (A) (B) (C) (D) (E) or (F) at the discretion of the Committee.

Members entering Section (A) may not enter sections (B).

Members entering Section (B) may not enter sections (A).

Members entering Section (C) may not enter sections (D).

Members entering Section (D) may not enter sections (C).

Members entering Section (E) may not enter sections (F).

Members entering Section (F) may not enter sections (E).

Monochrome Print of the Year

Members entering sections (A) and (B) may submit a maximum of four prints having gained a reasonable mark throughout the season.

Colour Print of the Year

Members entering section (C) and (D) may submit a maximum of four prints having gained a reasonable mark throughout the season.

DPI of the Year

Members entering sections (E) & (F) may submit a maximum of five images having gained a reasonable mark throughout the season.

Montage or Panel of Prints

Open to all members and shall consist of a minimum of 6 and maximum of 10 images mounted on board no greater than A2 in size. Images must be themed or tell a story. The number of entries is unlimited but may be restricted on the evening if an excessive number are submitted.

Memorial Competitions

Memorial competitions are open subjects for Colour & Mono prints and are not bound by the limitations of Sections (A) through (D).

The number of entries is unlimited but may be restricted on the evening if an excessive number are submitted.

The Committee reserve s the right to amend the Competition Rules if and when necessary.
